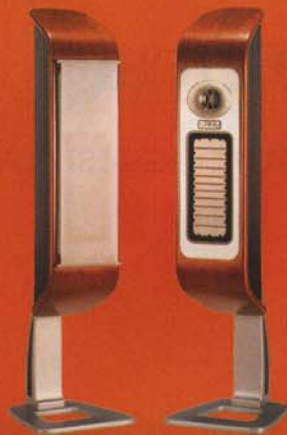

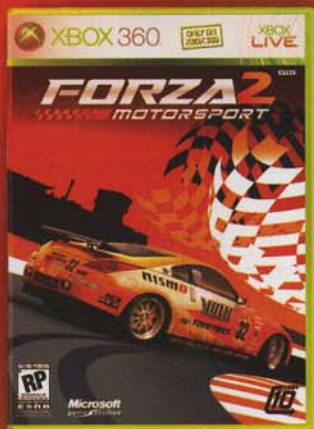
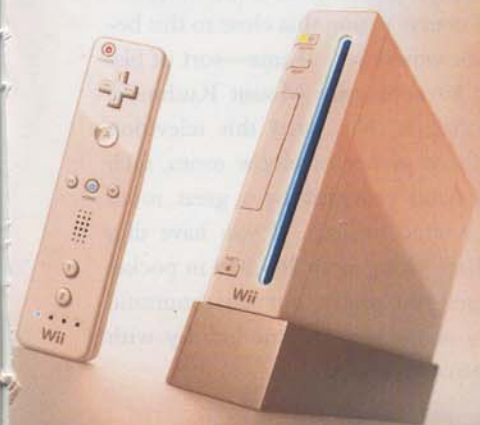

12 The combination of the surprisingly potent SUBstage under-couch subwoofer and the MAINstage HD speaker system makes the \$599 **Soundmatters FULL-stage** one of the most compact and satisfying virtual surround speaker systems. (soundmatters.com)

13 If a rock-shaped speaker doesn't suit the style of your garden, check out the new **StereoStone Stump**. It's available in three versions, all with an 8-inch woofer: a \$399 two-way conventional speaker, a \$459 single-point stereo model, and a \$399 subwoofer. (stereostone.com)

14 When combined with a subwoofer, the **Gallo Nucleus Micro Ti** satellite speakers make one of the coolest-looking, best-sounding home-theater-in-a-box systems ever created. The titanium-coned drivers in this \$200 speaker improve treble response over past versions. (roundsound.com)

15 KEF Five-2 speakers

Each **KEF Five-2 Model 7** and **Model 11** speaker (\$1,000 and \$1,800 per pair, respectively) has separate speakers for the left or right channel, the center channel, and the surround channel. So you can get nice surround from just two speakers. (kef.com)

16 Your new flat-panel TV deserves something better than the crummy speakers it came with—such as **Infinity's Cascade Model Five** speakers. Each of these \$699 beauties uses Infinity's new Maximum Radiating Surface driver for extra output and deeper bass. (infinitysystems.com)

17 Perfect for filling out the sound of a set of plasma TV speakers, the \$1,000 **Totem Storm** subwoofer puts out precise bass that is surprisingly full for a sub with an 8-inch driver and a 12-by-11-by-14-inch cabinet. (totemacoustic.com)
